

# Splashbacks & Cooktops Installation Guide

### Preparing the Wall:

- · Timber-framed Walls: Install fibre cement sheeting behind your SilkSurface splashback.
- · Brick Walls: Apply a cement-based render before fitting your splashback.

#### **Cutouts & Fixings:**

- · Cutouts for Powerpoints: These should be pre-routed by the fabricator, with rounded internal corners.
- Fixing Accessories: Utensil racks and similar items can be attached to a SilkSurface splashback. Use a tungsten-tipped drill bit, plastic wall plugs, and stainless steel screws. Keep drill holes at least 50mm away from edges or corners.


# Always follow the relevant building codes and Australian standards for clearances, especially behind cooktops, including:

- AS5601 2004 Gas Installations
- AS/NZS 4386.2:1996 Domestic Kitchen Assemblies Installation
- Manufacturer-specific installation guidelines for cooktops and appliances.



# **Electric and Induction Cooktops**

Maintain a minimum 50mm clearance between the cooktop's back edge and the splashback.



#### Gas Cooktops

A minimum 200mm clearance is required between the outer edge of the gas burner and the splashback, as per Australian Standard AS5601 for gas installations.
